- Arriving in New Orleans by 5pm on Tuesday, March 31st.
- Scheduling departure flights for 4:30pm or later on Thursday, April 2nd.

Location

The Ready by 21 National Meeting will be held at The Sheraton New Orleans Hotel on 500 Canal Street, New Orleans, LA 70130. Click [here](#) to see the physical location of the hotel on a map. Transportation

Airport and Shuttle Service

The closest airport is the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (MSY) which is 15 miles from The Sheraton New Orleans Hotel.

You may reserve a shared ride service between the Sheraton New Orleans Hotel and Louis Armstrong International Airport through New Orleans Airport Shuttle. Rates are \$20pp one way / \$38pp roundtrip. Taxis are available outside of baggage claim and the average fare to our New Orleans hotel is \$33.

Streetcar Transportation

The Sheraton hotel is also located right on the Streetcar line which provides easy transit along Canal Street, St. Charles Avenue, and the Riverfront. One-way cost: \$1.25. One, 3 and 5-day unlimited ride passes are also available for \$5, \$12 and \$20 respectively.

Hotel Parking

Valet parking service is available for guests (the hotel does not offer self-parking). Vehicles are secured in a covered garage adjacent to the hotel. Due to limited space and height restrictions parking is available on a first-come-first-served basis and they cannot accommodate oversized vehicles. Overnight guest rate is \$40 + tax.

General Driving Directions to the Sheraton New Orleans Hotel

From East

- Take Interstate 10 West to the Canal Street Exit #235B
- Turn right on Canal Street
- The hotel is about 10 blocks down on the right side (at the corner of Camp Street)

From North

- From the Causeway exit, take Interstate 10 East to the New Orleans Business District
- Continue to the Poydras Street exit
- Follow Poydras Street for approximately 8 blocks
- Turn left on Camp Street
- Continue on Camp Street for approximately 3 blocks
- The hotel will be on the right

From Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport

- Take Interstate 10 East to the New Orleans Business District
- Continue on to the Poydras Street Exit
- Continue down Poydras Street to Camp Street
- Turn left on Camp Street
- Go 3 blocks and the hotel will be on the right side on the corner of Camp and Canal

From South

- Take Highway 90 to the Westbank Expressway
- Proceed on the Westbank Expressway to the Crescent City Connection (approximately 10 miles)
- From the right lane, exit at Camp Street (8 red lights)
- Turn right on Canal Street

Dress Code

The convention center is minutes away and the hotel is located on the New Orleans Streetcar line, so you can catch a breezy, relaxing ride up Canal Street to City Park and the New Orleans Museum of Art.
